
Supportive Services for Veteran Families

SSVF Eligibility

<u>Amember of a "Veteran</u> family":

 Either (a) a Veteran; or (b) a member of a family in which the head of household, or the spouse of the head of household, is a Veteran.

<u>Low-income</u> <u>Household:</u>

 Income does not exceed 80 percent of area median income.

<u>Homeless or at risk of</u> homelessness:

- Is residing in housing and at risk of becoming literally homeless but for grantee's assistance.
- Is literally homeless and at risk to remain in this situation but for grantee's assistance.

Rapid Rehousing

- Designed to help veterans quickly exit homelessness
- Housing searches
- Applications
- Communicate with landlord
- Ensure rent is reasonable
- Review lease details



Homeless Prevention

- The objective is to save their current housing or assist them getting into a new place before their housing ends.
- Communicate with landlord
- Make plan to get caught up on rent or find new housing
- Needs Assessment
- Housing stability plan

Shallow Subsidy

- Allows for up to 24 months of rental subsidy not to exceed 50% of veterans base rent.
- Veteran must be able to consistently pay 50% of their rent.
- Veteran can increase their income and remain eligible.
